We're already working hard on planning our ski season, so we hope you're excited too! Here's some important program updates we'd like to share with you.

# **Key dates**

Online registration through <u>Snowline</u> will begin on **October 28 until November 24**, **2024**. Stay tuned for more details on how to register.

We'd love to see you at our virtual info-session on **Monday**, **November 4**, **7 p.m**. via <u>MS Teams</u>. Everyone is welcome to join, especially those who are new to the program or are still considering joining.

Our program will be held on **Monday evenings (7-9 p.m.)**, from **January 13 to March 17, 2025.** 

Mandatory guide training will be held on **Monday**, **January 6**, **starting at 6:30 p.m.** at Camp Fortune. <u>Eric Lacasse</u>, Technical Director, will reach out to all registered guides in December with further instructions. In the meantime, please mark your calendars.

# Membership fees (Updated)

Membership fees for skiers with equipment is now \$200. This covers lift tickets as well as annual memberships for CADS National and CADS-NCD, which are now \$45. The cost for equipment rental is an additional \$30.

Membership fees for guides is now \$45. This covers lift tickets as well as annual memberships for CADS National and CADS-NCD. Guides who are already registered in other CADS programs only need to pay their annual CADS membership once.

Criminal Record or Vulnerable Sector (Police) Check for new volunteers/guides (Updated)

All volunteers/guides over 18 years of age must obtain a valid Police Record or Vulnerable Sector Check every three years.

Ottawa residents can apply with the <u>Ottawa Police</u> and Quebec residents with the <u>Gatineau Police</u>. To avoid any fees, we can supply a signed letter on behalf of Ski Hawks Ottawa, upon request.

If you are a new volunteer/guide or a returning one who may not have had a chance to complete a criminal record check, please do so at your earliest convenience.

When applying, you may request a signed letter attesting your participation to the program. By doing so, you should avoid fees. Another option is to use the Sterling Backcheck offers in Snowline. This option is \$25.

Once your check is complete, please bring a copy (printed or on your phone) and show it to Jenny Curtis, Kim Leahy, or Eric Lacasse at the ski hill. We will then write down that you've completed the process in Snowline.

For returning guides, your Vulnerability Security Check will be honored as a CRC until it expired (3 years from date of issued)
